A Special Event With Annetta Kraayeveld September 25, 26, and 27, 2015 Textile Center, Minneapolis, Minnesota









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Minnesota Basket Weaver's Guild is excited to announce that Annetta Kraayeveld will be teaching 6 different classes over three days in September 2015 in collaboration with Minnesota Textile Center. All people are welcome to come and take classes.

Annetta's work ranges from traditional to artsy and from large to tiny baskets, working mostly in rattan reed and hand pounded black ash. Annetta finds that the challenge of mastering new techniques and weaving the pictures in her mind keep this an exciting art form.

Annetta considers herself a weaver, a teacher and a life-long student of 🏂 basketry. This fascination with baskets began when she was a young child. However, her weaving adventure didn't begin until 1995. She stumbled upon a weaving book and couldn't put it down. After hunting down a local weaver and begging a lesson, she was hooked. Since that 🛦 time Annetta has been largely self taught, learning from both her mistakes and successes. She weaves because she can't stop.

On September 25th (Friday), two classes will be offered:

5 pm to 8 pm: Papyrus - \$28/\$25 members*

This beautiful little basket is a wonderful introduction to weaving with painted paper. It is woven on a mold with start-stop rows so shaping of the basket will be a snap. A layered rim is lashed with waxed linen and a simple embellishment completes the basket. Choice of papers and embellishment will be available.



Level of experience suggested: advanced beginner to intermediate Special tools needed: small packer, sharp scissors and #22 tapestry needle Size: 4.5" x 2.75" x 1.75" high

5 pm to 8 pm: Whimsical Pins—\$39/\$35 members*

This fun little lapel pin is woven on a mold with black ash and lashed with waxed linen. The basket is woven continuously with a simple over 2 under 1 twill pattern and embellished with fun season-themed buttons. The pins will be started on the mold for you so you can finish within the class time. The kit will include materials for two pins: one will be finished in class and one will be finished at home.



Level of experience suggested: intermediate Special tools needed: small packer and small scissors, your own magnifier an option.

Size: 1.25" x 0.5 x 1" high

On September 26th (Saturday), two classes will be offered:

9 am to 4 pm: Flight — \$67/\$60 members*

A striking little basket, filled with fun techniques. Students will learn how to weave a beautiful chevron base and how to lattice twine. Shaping techniques will be emphasized. Students will be able to choose from a Variety of dyed Hamburg cane.



Level of experience suggested: intermediate Special tools needed: a size #20 tapestry needle

Size: 6.25" x 6.25" x 4" high

9 am to 4 pm: Evening — \$83/\$75 members*



This basket is an elegant twist on the simple but beautiful lines of the "Williamsburg" basket. Beginning with a wooden base, the class will focus on shaping the gentle rounded flare of the classic "Williamsburg" form, then a few decrease rows will be added to accent the shape. The final emphasis of the class will be the "Gretchen" or the rolled border. The students will concentrate on understanding the technique while creating a smooth and seamless rim.

Level of experience suggested: intermediate Special tools needed: a size #20 tapestry needle

Size: 11" x 8.5" x 10" high

On September 27th (Sunday), two classes will be offered:

9 am to 4 pm: Porphyry - \$72/\$65 members*

This is such a fun basket to weave and stunning to display. The basket is woven in three colors (natural, black plum, and purple) to accent everything from the herringbone base to the overlays. This basket sports two distinct twills as well as two rims. This class focuses on shaping a cathead urn and careful color placement.

Level of experience suggested: intermediate Special tools needed: a size #20 tapestry needle

Size: 12" diameter x 9" high



9 am to 4 pm: Arrows - \$83/\$75 members*



Arrows is a over 5, under 5 twill from base to rim. Careful placement of stakes and weavers brings out the arrow design and Careful attention to shaping brings this basket from a square base to a circular top. After applying an overlay on the rim, the basket is lashed with waxed linen.

Level of experience suggested: intermediate

Required: Twill experience

Special tools needed: a size #20 tapestry needle

Size: 10" diameter" x 12" high
